

Principle of Prevention

1. Avoid Risk

Effective way of avoiding risk is to entirely eliminate the hazard that gives rise to risk in the first place. Analyze the corruption risk





2. Adopting effective and coordinated policies against corruption. Developing a coherent anti-corruption policy which identifies the causes of corruption and commits to practical, coordinated an effective measures to address these causes.

Principle of Prevention

3. Fair and transparent system of procurement. Establishing a procurement system, built on the principles of objectivity, transparency and competition.





4. Strengthening the integrity within the company. Ensuring the administration of the company is transparent, accountable to the staff, free of conflicts of interest, free to be reported and operates on the basis of clear rules.

Effect of Corruption

 Organisational impacts of corruption > damage to employee morale Individual impacts of corruption > disciplinary action 2. Community impacts of corruption > lower community confidence in public authorities 3.
